Carmen Sales Dotson, 99, of Rusk, Texas, passed away on Thursday, March 22, 2018, in Tyler, Texas where she was hospitalized, being treated for a stroke. She was born on February 11, 1919 to Sim Oliver Sales and Linnet Eliza Stevenson Sales of Atoy, Texas.

She is survived by her son Dennis Dotson of Houston as well as by numerous nieces, nephews, cousins, and many close friends. She was preceded in death by her husband, Roy T. Dotson.

Carmen was for many years a member of the First United Methodist Church in Rusk, where she eventually became the oldest member and unofficial matriarch. She loved to sing and was a member of the choir at First United Methodist Church. For several years, she performed with the Cherokee Civic Theater group and sang and acted onstage in numerous productions; it was one of her biggest joys.
