Funeral services for Glenn A. Miller, age 94, of Rusk are scheduled for 10:00 a.m., Monday, October 24, 2016 in the First Presbyterian Church in Rusk with Rev. Don Copeland officiating. Interment will be in Holcomb Cemetery under the direction of Wallace-Thompson Funeral Home in Rusk.

Mr. Miller passed away October 20, 2016 in a Jacksonville hospital. He was born June 25, 1922 in San Augustine, TX to the late Inlow Lee and Nina Mathews Miller. 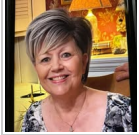
