Memorial services for Jerry Bob Helm, age 60, of Rusk are scheduled for 2:00 p.m., Saturday, January 12, 2013 in First Baptist Church in Rusk with Rev. Don Copeland officiating.

Mr. Helm died January 3, 2013 at his residence. He was born January 4, 1952 in Nacogdoches, TX to the late Marvin Dick Helm and Ernestine Wallace Helm Wise. Mr. Helm was a resident of Rusk most of his life and also lived in Houston where he worked for KRBE Radio as a Disc Jockey for over 10 years.
