Funeral services for Joel Louis Lloyd, age 30, of Nacogdoches are scheduled for 10:00 a.m., Wednesday, October 10, 2012 in Wallace-Thompson Funeral Home Chapel with Rev. Don Copeland officiating. Mr. Lloyd died October 6, 2012 in a Tyler Hospital. He was born June 24, 1982 in Nacogdoches, TX. 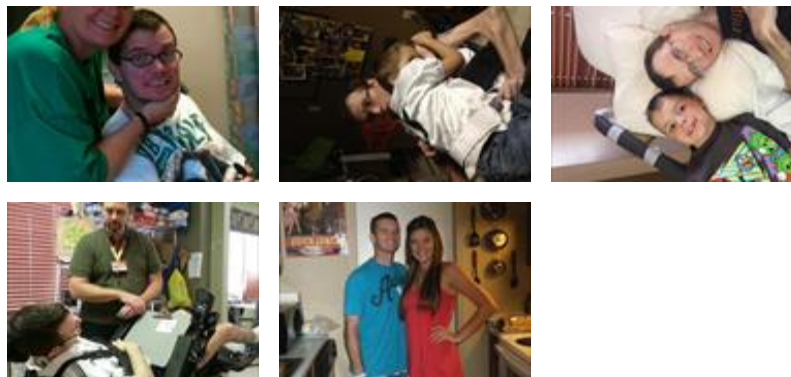
