Mr. Lloyd Llewellyn Shields, 87, passed away Tuesday, August 19 in Jacksonville, Texas. He was born April 21, 1938, in St. Elizabeth, Jamaica to Maxwell and Daisy Shields.

He started working with Shell Oil in Jamaica, then left to pursue his education at Texas Southern University, earning a bachelor's in business administration and accounting. He then earned his master's in accounting at the University of Wisconsin. He was then recruited by Bank of Chicago (now Chase) to return to Jamaica and worked for Bank of Chicago until his return to Houston where he worked for First City Bank and later Texas Commerce Bank (now Chase).

Lloyd enjoyed fixing cars, especially his air-cooled VW's. He also loved growing flowers and tangerines. He loved all kinds of music, records and hymns. He loved music so much that he ensured his children were musically inclined, each singing and playing the piano. He was active in the Seventh Day Adventist Church and was a Head Elder and Sabbath School Teacher.

He is preceded in death by his father. He is survived by his mother, Daisy Shields.
