

## Roy Vanburn Brewer

September 14, 1932 - March 26, 2014

Funeral services for Roy Vanburn Brewer, age 81, of Rusk are scheduled for 2:00 p.m., Saturday, March 29, 2014 in First Baptist Church in Rusk with Rev. Donnie Barron, Rev. Don Copeland and Rev. Don Richey officiating. Interment will be in Cedar Hill Cemetery under the direction of Wallace-Thompson Funeral Home in Rusk.

Mr. Brewer passed away March 26, 2014 at his residence. He was born September 14, 1932 in Weatherford, TX to the late Clyde V. and Orean Evans Brewer Sr. Mr. Brewer was a Rusk native and retired back to Rusk in 1994. He was a member of First Baptist Church in Rusk and was a deacon at Calvary Baptist Church in Beaumont, TX and a founding member of Heritage Park Baptist Church in Friendswood, TX. Mr. Brewer was a member of the Young Mens Business League in Beaumont and a member of the 1950 Lon Morris State Champion basketball team. He also served 9 years in the Texas National Guard and was a board member of the Cherokee Civic Theater in Rusk.
