Barbara is a close family friend whom Sally looked up to. Sally also became a certified Jazzercise instructor. She graduated from the University of Texas San Antonio. Sally also enjoyed travelling and became a Flight Attendant with Delta Airlines in 1998, where she got to fulfill her dreams by travelling to such places as Dubai, Paris, Budapest, Jordan and many others throughout the world.

Sally is survived by her Mother, Geraldine Struhall of Rusk, brothers; James Struhall Jr. of Bullard and Larry Struhall of Dallas. 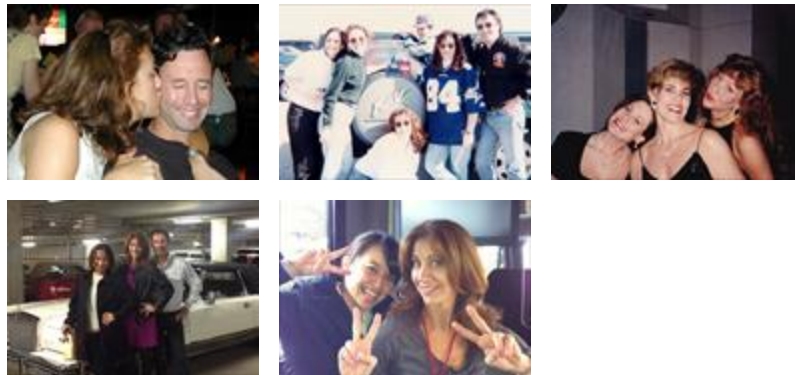
