January 19, 1929 - July 30, 2013

Graveside services for Sue Kyle, age 84, of Arcadia, Louisiana are scheduled for 4:00 p.m., Thursday, August 1, 2013 in Cedar Hill Cemetery under the direction of Wallace-Thompson Funeral Home in Rusk. Survivors are her daughter, Kay Rice of Flint, TX, her son, Kelly Kyle of Jackson, Mississippi, granddaughters, Karen Rice Williams (Daniel) of Temple, TX, Susan Rice Cannon Hawley (Mike) of Whitehouse, TX, three great grandchildren, Claire and Logan Cannon and Mark Williams.
